Detour for Through Traffic and Veteran's Park Users**

Dear Business Owner/Operator:

Work on the Industrial Park Area Improvements project will begin as early as **the week of August 10th**. With a completion date of mid-October, this project is on a tight time schedule, and the contractor must work swiftly. They will more readily be able to do so without the presence of unnecessary traffic and the disruption and safety concerns it brings.

The street segments within the project area are:


- *Spiral Boulevard between Highway 316 & Enterprise Avenue*
- *Millard Avenue between 31st Street and Veteran's Park*
- *Industrial Court*
- *Commerce Drive between Spiral Boulevard and Millard Avenue***

These roads will remain open for local business traffic (employees, owners, clients, & deliveries). ***Although this segment of Commerce Drive is not being reconstructed with this project, it can only be accessed from Spiral Boulevard and Millard Avenue, and so it will also be open to only business traffic.*

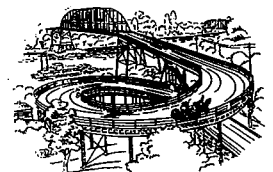
A detour will be set up for all through traffic and traffic destined for Veteran's Park to use 31st Street and Enterprise Avenue as a bypass of the project area. For your information, a map has been included on the reverse side of this letter showing the above described detour routes.

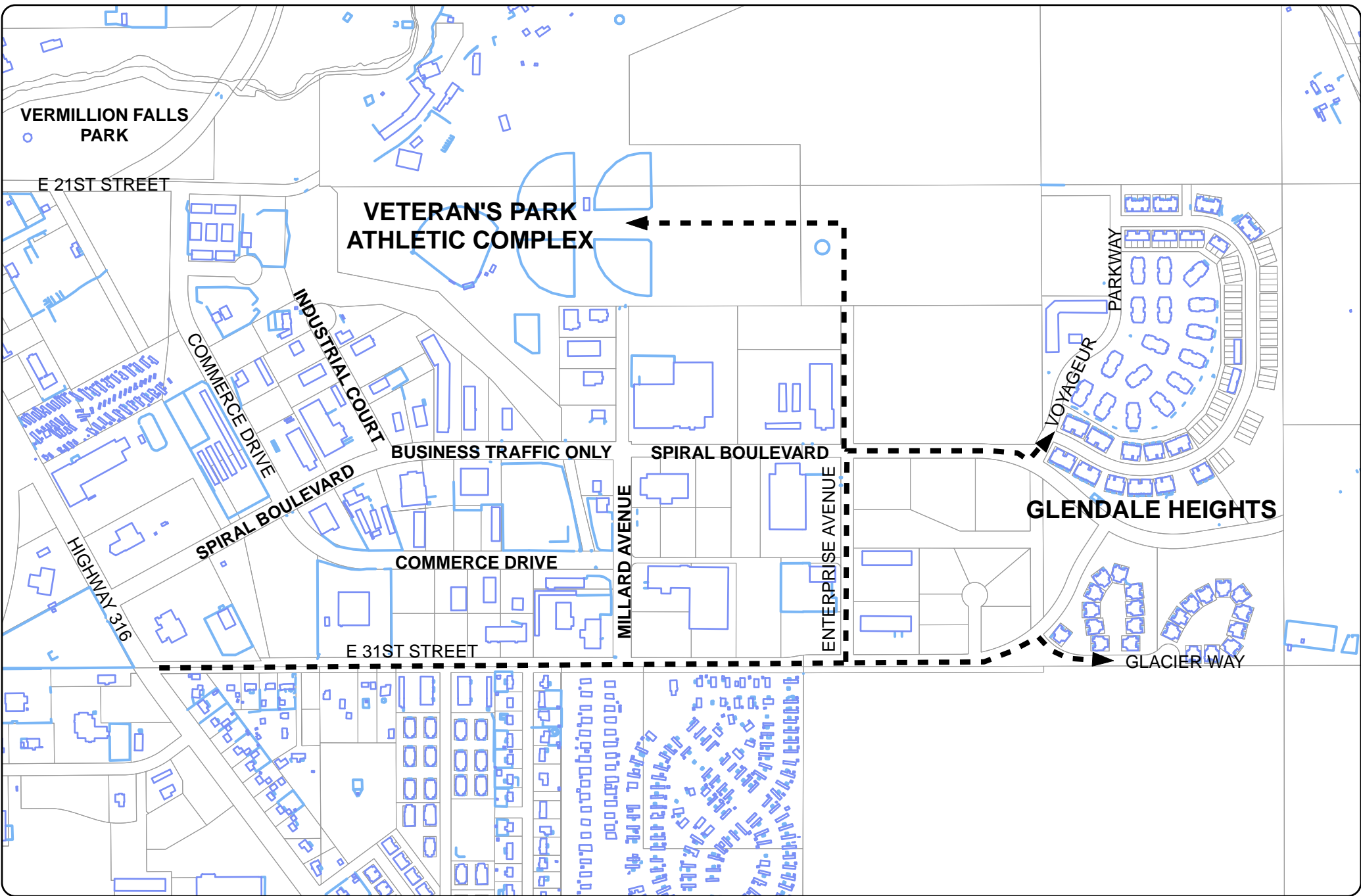
