Dear Residents, Contractors, Haulers, and Developers:

We look forward to another construction season this year, however, this time of the year compels us to remind you of the impending load restrictions period.

A revision to Minnesota Statute 169.87 dictates that all loads on paved roads within the City will be limited to 10 tons per axle during the Spring Load Restriction period unless otherwise posted. However, because many roads within the City have not been constructed for this heavier loading, the City is requesting that loads in excess of 5 tons per axle utilize the streets listed on the back of this letter as much as possible.

The City of Hastings will place limits into effect at the same time as the Minnesota Department of Transportation. MnDOT will initiate spring load restrictions at 12:01 AM on Monday, March 8, 2010. Please schedule deliveries to avoid hauling oversized loads during this period. The City WILL be enforcing load restrictions.

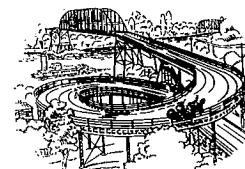
